

☛ When Richard O'Neill, Jr., died in 1943, his interests passed to his wife, Marguerite, & their children, Alice & Richard Jerome. ☛ That year a permanent O'Neill Brand, the 'Rafter-tail M,' was created for Rancho Mission Viejo. ☛ Once again the Plano returned to agriculture, including grain, groves & grazing.



☛ To perpetuate the 200-year heritage of the land, in 1979, SANTA MARGARITA CO. was reincorporated to manage and develop Rancho Mission Viejo and other O'Neill family properties. ☛ Therefore, on May 30, 1985, ground was broken on Plano Trabuco for the 5,000-acre urban village of Rancho Santa Margarita.
