

COVID-19 Vaccination Update

January 22, 2021

The Orange County Health Care Agency administers vaccinations.
Cities do not have access to vaccines.

Vaccination sites are called Super PODs (Point of Dispensing) and are located at Disneyland Resort (currently) and Soka University (opens 1/22).

More Super POD sites will open as the supply of COVID-19 vaccines in the County increases.

Vaccines dispensed at County Super PODs are currently available for people who live and work in Orange County and fall within the State's Phase 1A, all tiers, including people 65 and older.

Appointments are available through Othena.com based on vaccine availability.
Eligible people with an appointment must present identification and proof of eligibility at the Super POD site to receive a vaccine.
